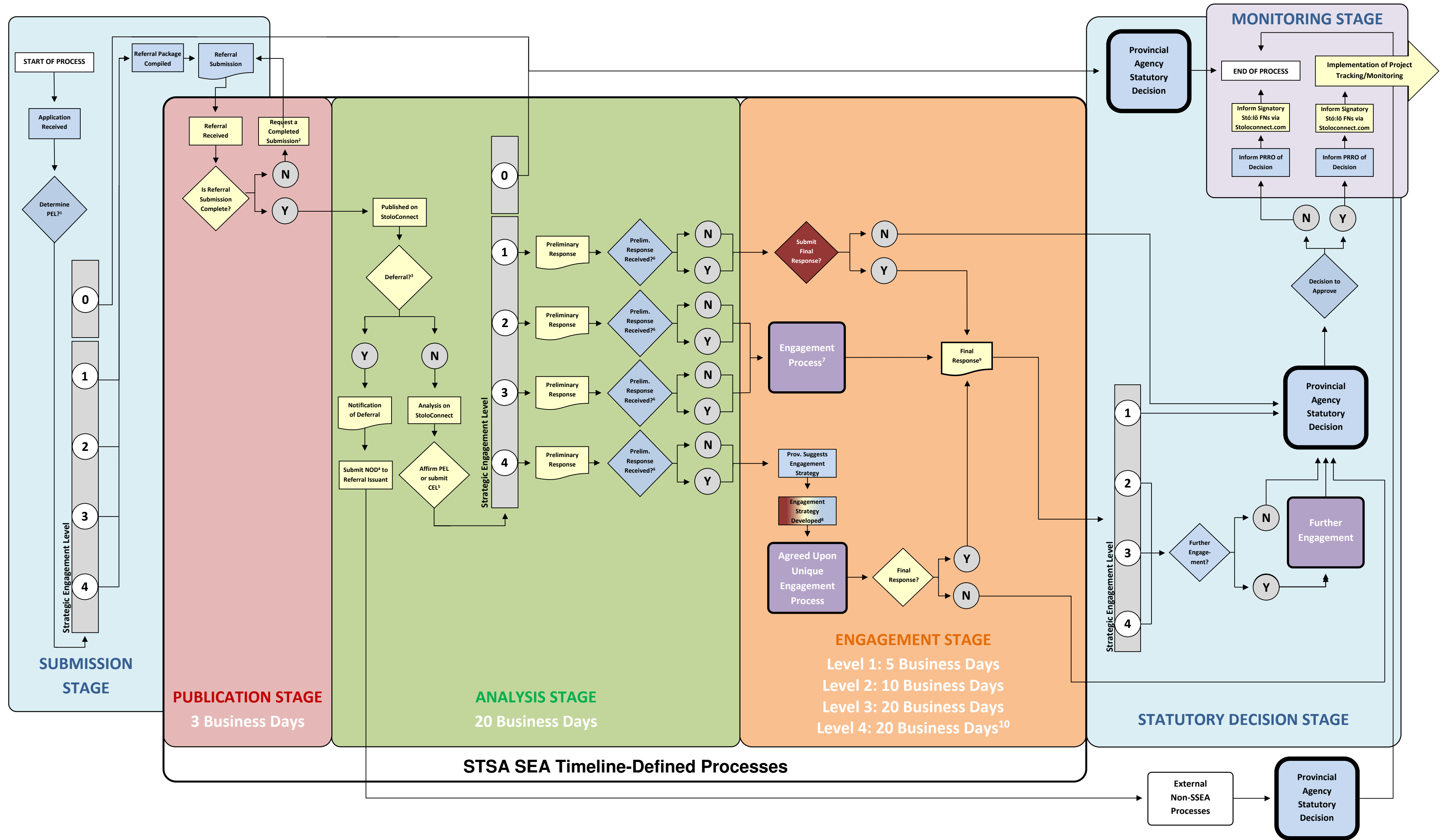
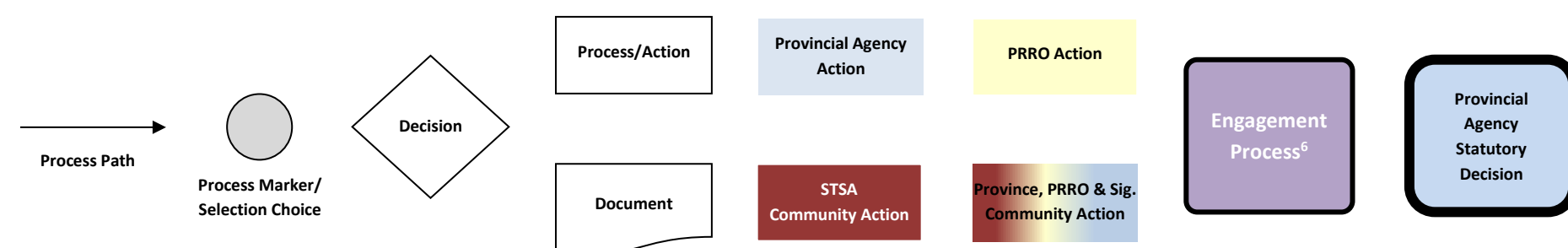


# S'ólh Téméxw Stewardship Alliance Strategic Engagement Agreement - Engagement Framework Process Map

- <sup>1</sup>PEL stands for **Proposed Engagement Level**. Levels defined in Article 7 Table 1 of the Engagement Framework.
- <sup>2</sup>Required Information for a complete submission is listed in SSEA Engagement Framework sec. 2.3 and includes GIS spatial data. If spatial data is unavailable, a publication delay will occur to allow PRRO to digitally map the project in question.
- <sup>3</sup>Deferred referrals are those projects within S'ólh Téméxw (SSEA geographic scope) but outside the self-identified STSA Core-Interest Areas. They are deferred to communities in closer proximity to the works in question for comment.
- <sup>4</sup>NOD stands for **Notification of Deferral**.
- <sup>5</sup>CEL stands for **Confirmed Engagement Level**. See SSEA Engagement Framework sec. 2.5.
- <sup>6</sup>Should the Provincial Agency not receive a Preliminary Response they shall notify the PRRO. Timelines and due-dates will remain unaffected.
- <sup>7</sup>In brief, a discussion between Provincial Agency Staff, Signatory Communities, and the PRRO on topics raised in the Preliminary Response. May include meetings if requested.
- <sup>8</sup>Provincial Agency Staff, Signatory Communities, and the PRRO develop a Unique Engagement Process which may or may not result in a Final Response. Discussion may be undertaken through the Working Group if requested.
- <sup>9</sup>Should no Final Response be received within the prescribed timelines or within an agreed-upon revised timeframe, a decision on the Application may be made without further notice after a further 5 Business Days for a Level 2, or 10 Business Days for a Level 3.
- <sup>10</sup>20 Days to formulate a unique process, not to complete the Final Response itself.
